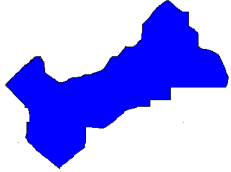

**We Need Area Leader
Teams**

Each Area Leader Team is comprised of 3 Leaders responsible for building a team of Democratic activists within their district.

Sub Area Leads

The Sub Area Leaders are each responsible for recruiting, training and supporting Precinct Captains within the Service Area of our District.

Precinct Captains

Precinct Captains are the basic grassroots organizers of the Democratic Party. They live in their Precinct and communicate with their neighbors regarding the Democratic Party projects and issues affecting the area. Each Precinct Captain should recruit at least one helper—Precinct Worker. The primary responsibility of the Precinct Captain is on-going contact with the Democratic Voters in the Precinct using tried and proven techniques such as the “House Party”, Newsletter and personal contact.

General Trainers

Trainers will be working with the Party and the County Lead developing curriculums for training Area Leads, Sub Area Leads, Precinct Captains and Precinct Workers. They will then be conducting training sessions for the volunteers.

Technical Trainers

Technical Trainers need to be computer literate and will learn the *Democratic Voter* program, web based, campaign support software, so that they can train and support the online users

Volunteer Coordinators

The Volunteer Coordinators work with the Leaders of the overall organization contacting activists and coordinating their activities.
